

**SALSA Field Report: 7 Dec 2018. Compiled by Matt Siegfried.**

**SALSA Geophysics/SALSA EM, Location: Camp 20**

- We woke up this morning to our first overcast skies with flat light. We would keep an eye on the weather as we went about our tasks for the day: dig out and return the only remaining MT station to camp and pack camp in preparation for our 75 mile move to Whillans Subglacial Lake.
- Weather cleared through the day, with intermittent wind and light blowing snow. Our planned day went as expected, with an easy dig and methodical packing. We made the decision in the mid afternoon to take our time packing and move Sunday instead of rushing to leave tomorrow. The end result is the same: science operations likely (re)starting Tuesday in either case.
- We ended the day with all camp cargo on sleds, leaving us with a morning off tomorrow. In the afternoon, we'll finish up strapping up sleds and readying our tents for a quick takedown Sunday morning.
